GENERAL INFORMATION

- The award of Merit is a Council Award, presented by DISTRICTS in the same manner that the Silver Beaver is a National Award presented by COUNCILS.
- The Award is available to Scouters who render service of an outstanding nature at the District level.
- The Award is made available on the basis of 1 for each 25 units or fraction thereof. The District need not present all the Awards to which it is entitled each year.

REQUIREMENTS

- A Nominee must be a registered Scouter.
- A Nominee must have rendered noteworthy service to boys.

The nature and value of “noteworthy service to boys” may consist of a single plan or decisions that contributed vitally to the lives of large numbers of boys or may have been given to a small group over an extended period of time.

- The Nominee should have contributed some service to youth outside of Scouting.
- Consideration should be given to the nominee’s position and the corresponding opportunity to render outstanding service beyond the expectation of duty.
- A Nominee’s attitude toward and cooperation with the District and Council is taken into consideration.

PROCEDURE

1. Annually, District Chairman will appoint a District Award of Merit Committee of not more than five persons who will consider all candidates and make recommendations. The committee’s term of office shall be for one year or until the Annual District Meeting.
2. These recommendations should be submitted confidentially to the District Executive who will inform the District Chairman.

The following procedure is suggested for such presentation ceremonies.

- A. If possible, the recipient and spouse should be in attendance at the Annual Meeting or Awards Dinner.
- B. A district officer and/or council officer should explain the award and its significance.
- C. Eagle Scouts should be asked to escort the recipients to a place of honor at the head table or stage.
- D. A suitable citation for each recipient should be read, indicating what each has done in Scouting.
- E. The award should be presented at this time with appropriate congratulations.
- F. A group picture may be taken for use in neighborhood newspapers. (District responsibility).
