Please complete the two page application. By applying to become a Counselor in Training (C.I.T.), you are committing to the same code of conduct policy as the Onteora Staff. Upon successful completion to the course, you may be asked to remain in camp as a volunteer staff member. Acceptance of a volunteer position will reinforce your training, and further you camp staff experience.
